


Winter is Here - Please be Prepared!

Both Virginia and Loudoun County Codes require that the occupant - whether an owner or a tenant - remove all snow and ice from any walkway adjoining any part of their property within 6 hours after the snowfall has ceased.

If the snow or ice fell during the night, it must be removed by Noon the following day. Should the storm occur on Sunday, the accumulation must be removed by Noon on Monday.

Failure to comply with the Code can result in a fine of \$250.00 imposed by the county. Complaints should be reported to the County Department of Building and Development, (703) 777-0635.

Please be a good neighbor and a good citizen. Clear your walkways and keep Broadlands a safe environment for all our residents. If you know someone physically unable to keep their walkway clear, please consider giving them a helping

Kritters for Kids... By: Broadlands ANS Naturalist, Lisa Matthews

Have you ever heard a frog bark? No? In Virginia and Maryland, we have a special kind of tree frog that makes an interesting barking sound. It is called the Barking Tree Frog. Unfortunately, they are on the endangered lists for Virginia and Maryland.



They can only live in certain places which puts them in danger to go extinct in some areas when their habitat is reduced. When an animal no longer lives where it used to live, it is called "extirpation". If it no longer exists anywhere in the world, then it is extinct.

The Department of Game and Inland Fisheries is responsible for looking after all of the wildlife in our state and protecting it. They consider the Barking Tree Frog to have a "very high conservation need" and are actively working to help save the Barking Tree Frog from disappearing from our coastal areas and the areas near them with sandy soil and pine forests. These frogs like to be near grassy water, streams, cypress ponds and bay heads. They like woods that have a lot of light.

Their scientific name is Hyla gratiosa which means "belonging to the woods" and "favored or pleasing". This might be because they are pretty frogs or it could be because their "bark" is a lovely sound. You can hear what they sound like by visiting this site: http://www.youtube.com/watch?v=rctt0dhCHxs

They are the biggest tree frog in Virginia, ranging from 2 to 2.6 inches and are found to be gray, green or even purple. They usually have oval or round spots that are circled with a black line. They have a light stripe down their sides with a darker stripe below that and have reddish spots around their faces.

When it is not too hot you can find them in the trees, but when it is really hot, they burrow underground to keep from drying out (like most amphibians). Their favorite foods are any insects that live in the forest.

Look for these amazing frogs next time you visit Virginia Beach. Remember, you'll need to locate a woodland to see them!

Ten Expert Bird Feeding Tips

- **1.** Always place your bird feeders in places where you can readily and frequently see the birds you are feeding.
- **2.** Start with the basics. Black-oil sunflower in a tubular feeder is a very effective combination for attracting a large number of birds to your yard.



- **3.** Attract more species by adding additional types of feeders and seed. Try Nyjer® in a tube feeder, and mixtures of black-oil sunflower, sunflower hearts, and whole peanuts in hopper and platform feeders.
- **4.** Don't forget about alternative foods and water. Suet, fruits, mealworms, nectar and water may attract species of birds not found at traditional offerings.



- **5.** The bird species in your yard change with each season of the year. The birds visiting your feeders in summer may be very different than those in winter. Provide the feeders and food best suited to your seasonal suite of birds.
- **6.** Make your yard bird-friendly. Provide birds with habitat, food, water, and nest boxes so birds will use your yard year-round. Bird feeders near larger trees and shrubs often have more bird visits.

Invite some colorful chirps to your garden, for example, by offering:

For Eastern Blue Birds

- Bird Food: Fruit
- **Bird Feeder:** Fruit and mealworms
- Woody Plants: Smooth sumac and sumac
- Non-woody Plants: Mistletoe

For Red-bellied Woodpecker

- **Bird Food:** Black-oil sunflower, striped sunflower, suet, sunflower hearts, and whole peanuts
- Bird Feeder: Tube, hopper, platform, peanut, and suet
- **Woody Plants:** Flamboyant tree, pin oak, slash pine, and sugar maple
- **7.** Keep the birds safe. Reduce window collisions, keep birds safe from outdoor cats, and clean your feeders. Move feeders to within 3 feet of windows, remove hiding places of cats, and keep feeders free of debris and filled only with seeds birds will eat.
- **8.** Use binoculars and a backyard bird guide to learn more about your birds. Learning more about birds by using the tools of the birdwatcher provides you with a greater appreciation for your feathered friends.
- **9.** Take your hobby to the next level. Explore your local, state, and national parks and refuges. You will see bird species you can't see in your yard.
- **10.** If you need expert help, contact **National Bird-Feeding Society**. They are the ultimate resource for enhancing your wild bird-feeding experience.

MUSSELS SOUTH OF TWO BORDERS

A delicious Latin American preparation that combines chorizo, chiles and beer.

- 1/3 cup diced Spanish chorizo (see Shopping Tip)
- 1 medium onion, diced
- 1 small plum tomato, diced
- 2 tablespoons chopped canned green chiles, drained
- 1 teaspoon ground cumin
- 1/2 teaspoon freshly ground pepper
- 1 cup beer, preferably dark Mexican beer, such as Negra Modelo
- 2 pounds mussels, scrubbed and debearded if necessary (see Tip)

1/4 cup chopped fresh cilantro Cook chorizo in a large saucepan over medium heat until brown, 3 to 5 minutes. Add onion; cook until softened, about 3 minutes. Stir in tomato, chiles, cumin and pepper; cook, until the tomato begins to break down, about 3 minutes. Pour in beer, increase heat to medium-high, and bring to a boil, scraping up any browned bits. Stir in mussels and simmer. Cover, reduce heat to medium-low, and cook just

until the mussels have opened, about

7 minutes. Remove from the heat

FILET MIGNON WITH CARAWAY CILANTRO COMPOUND BUTTER

Compound butter is a classic sauce for steak, and this version boasts the unusual combination of caraway and cilantro. This method of cooking filet mignon is very straightforward, and yields a beautifully juicy result every time.


- 3 tablespoons unsalted butter, at room temperature
- 2 tablespoons finely chopped cilantro
- 1/2 teaspoon caraway seed
- 1/2 teaspoon fresh lemon juice
- 1 teaspoon kosher salt
- 1/2 teaspoon black pepper
- 1 tablespoon extra-virgin olive oil
- 2 (6 ounce) filet mignon, tied (about 11/2-inchesthick)


Stir together butter, cilantro, caraway, lemon juice, ½ teaspoon kosher salt and 1/4 teaspoon pepper. Place compound butter in a piece of wax paper and roll into a cylinder, then refrigerate until ready to use. Sprinkle steaks with remaining ½ teaspoon kosher salt and ¼ teaspoon pepper. Heat oil in medium heavy skillet

Landscape Design in Winter By Edye Clark, Master Gardener

Winter is a great time to evaluate your existing landscape, when it is most bare and your gardening pleasures—and chores—have lessened. It is the time of year when the "bones" of your garden areas are easiest to see and you can begin to assess what you have and what you may like to change or add — by looking not only at trees, shrubs and perennials, but also hardscapes, water features and garden structures. It's also a great time to think about making changes to incorporate elements of conservation landscaping so your property can help protect clean air and water, and provide habitat for birds, butterflies and other wildlife. Information and guidelines for conservation landscaping can be found at the Chesapeake Conservation Landscaping Council's website, www. chesapeakelandscape.org.

Assessing the key viewsheds on a property is one step landscape design professionals consider when starting a project and an activity you can do indoors right now. A viewshed is an area of land, water, or other element that is visible from a fixed vantage point.

You can locate your key viewsheds just by looking out your windows. Windows are like frames to the landscape outside. Pour yourself a cup of hot tea and spend some time gazing out, especially when there isn't any snow. Snow hides a multitude of sins. What do you see? What do you like? What would you alter to make a more pleasing vista? Looking out through the windows helps give you a starting point in your own landscape, one manageable view at a time.




