Loudoun County Public Schools is holding an Open Forum Public Hearing on two Safe Routes to Schools Projects: Pedestrian crossing on Ashburn Road at Broad Run High School entrance; and pedestrian crosswalks along Ridgeway Drive near Mill Run Elementary School. The Public Hearing will be held at Loudoun County Public Schools Administration Building on Thursday, April 28, 2016, from 6:30 p.m. to 8:30 p.m. Loudoun County Public Schools Administration Building, Rooms 102A and B, located at 21000 Education Court, Ashburn, VA 20148.

The Broad Run High School project proposes the enhancement of the existing high visibility crosswalk located on the south side of the intersection of Ashburn Road and the entrance to Broad Run High School/Suzanne Hope Way, with ground mounted warning signs with flashing beacons. The Mill Run Elementary School project proposes three at-grade crosswalks on Ridgeway Drive at the intersections of Laurier Drive/Glyndebourne Court, Engleside Place and Mapleton Court. Improvements are proposed within the existing right-of-way. No additional right-of-way or utility relocations are needed. There are no environmental impacts with these projects.
