RE: County survey around Bullfrog Pond

Dear Homeowner:

The County of Loudoun is responsible for the four inlet pipes that take stormwater into the pond. Representatives of the county's Department of General Services, Public Works Division oversee the stormwater management program. Their engineers have advised us that they will be surveying the pond inlets in the coming weeks to delineate the tree preserve and protected wetlands areas. Land surveyors will mark these areas with stakes and/or tape. Please **DO NOT REMOVE** or relocate these survey markers. The survey work will not encroach onto any private property and will not hinder activities. We expect surveying to be performed in January. Additional information regarding work to be performed will be distributed in the coming months as further details are received.
