Annual Meeting of the Membership

The most important meeting of the year will be held on Tuesday, May 7th at 7:00pm at the Broadlands Clubhouse – the Annual Meeting of the Membership. This meeting, held every year in order to elect the Board of Directors, is required by the Bylaws for Broadlands Association, Inc. and the quorum requirement is at least ten percent of the total number of votes of the association and must be present in person or by proxy. You should have received official notification of this meeting via USPS mail around April 1.

This year, we have three open positions, each for three year terms. We received nominating forms and petitions from four candidates; David Baroody, Eric Bazerghi, Todd Parsons, and John Zuccaro. Their nominating forms are included on pages 10 - 13 of this newsletter.

Some of the powers and duties of the Board include: providing goods and services in accordance with the documents and providing for the upkeep of the common area; designating, hiring, and dismissing personnel necessary to providing for the upkeep of the common area and providing goods and services; collecting and depositing assessments; adopting and amending rules and regulations; opening bank accounts; enforcing provisions of the documents; obtaining and carrying insurance; paying for authorized goods and services; charging reasonable fees for the use of the common area; suspending the right of an owner or occupant to vote or to use common areas; preparing and adopting an annual budget and establishing assessments; borrowing money on behalf of the association; and employing a managing agent. The full list of powers and duties can be found in the Bylaws for Broadlands.

The Articles of Incorporation provide that the Board be comprised of nine people elected to serve in staggered terms of three years each. Eligible Board Members include owners, owner's spouses, an officer, trustee, general partner or agent of an owner, the Declarant or designee of the Declarant, or a mortgagee or designee of the mortgagee. Owners or representatives of owners may not be more than sixty days delinquent in meeting financial obligations to the association.

In 2015, the Board of Directors moved from a paper voting system to an online voting system by hiring The Inspectors of Election. Official meeting notices are still mailed to all owners of record, but are also emailed with a link to the website to those owners for which we have valid email addresses. This step made it possible for the HOA to achieve a quorum of owners for the first time, other than at the Transition Meeting in 2009. Every other year, the Declarants' attendance made quorum possible because less than 10% of the membership participated at

the meeting in person or by proxy.

Please take a few moments to log onto tieivote.com with your unique username and password (provided to you in the official mailing and via email for those previously registered) to submit your proxy if you are unable to attend the meeting in person. You may elect to use your proxy for quorum purposes only or you may cast votes for us to four candidates. Are You Selling Your Home?

Save yourself time and aggravation by ensuring you have approved applications for all exterior changes or additions made on your property before listing your home. Walk around your home and look for any maintenance violations such as siding repair, exterior trim maintenance, fence/ deck repair, any staining touch up, or roof repair. Refer to your property plat to locate your property lines because you may have accidentally placed something in the common area that will need to be removed before settlement.

When you sell your home you are required to request a resale disclosure package for the buyer. Once the request has been executed it notifies the HOA to come to your property to perform a resale inspection. The inspectors will look for any structures that have not been approved by the Modifications Subcommittee, structures that are not in compliance and for maintenance violations. The results of the resale inspection are embedded in the resale disclosure package that is provided for the buyer. It is the owner's responsibility to rectify all violations found on the property before settlement of the home. If the violations are not rectified before settlement then, the new owner will be responsible.

There are submission procedures on the HOA website, broadlandshoa.org, to help guide you through the application process. Please refer to the online Design Guidelines for detailed information.

The Design Guidelines provide a framework to maintain design quality and encourage consistency throughout the community. Covenants Corner



Mildew, Wood Trim & Faded Shutters

Spring brings a very busy time for covenants. This month, the Inspector will be focusing on several issues: homes with mildew on the siding, stoops, etc., rotten wood trim, and faded shutters and doors. Mildew detracts from the aesthetics of the community and is often found on areas that receive little or no sunlight. Rotten wood can often be identified by paint that is cracked, peeling, or blistering, or wood that's darker than the surrounding area or green with algae. Shutters and doors that have faded from their original color should be freshened up.

The Inspectors will also continue performing house to house inspections, checking the front, back, and sides of each unit for improvements that have been made without prior approval from the Modification Subcommittee.

If any violation of these types are noted, the owner will be mailed a letter providing sixty days for the violation to be resolved. If the violation is not corrected, a second violation letter will be issued, providing an additional fifteen day extension. If the violation remains unresolved, a final notice will be sent, providing seven days to rectify before a Hearing Notice is sent, and a Hearing will be held in accordance with state law, where charges may be assessed, up to \$10/day for a maximum of ninety (90) days.

If you have questions regarding this processes, or have corrected the violation(s), or if you would like to request an extension on a maintenance violation, please contact the Covenants office at covenants@broadlandshoa.com or Suzan Rodano, Covenants Manager at 703-729-9704, option 2.

Throughout the year, the Covenants Manager routinely inspects homes for a variety of issues ranging from trash containers in open view, parking issues, architectural modifications to leftover holiday décor. In addition, certain seasons dictate the need to focus on particular inspections where violations may occur with high frequency.

This helps preserve the property values for home ownership, promotes community harmony and ensures the high standards of living that our residents have come to expect are maintained.

Plastic Bags CANNOT Be Recycled!

In the past month Patriot Disposal has been experiencing extremely high levels of contaminated recycle loads due to the use of plastic bags. The use of plastic bags causes many issues, mainly by clogging the machinery at the recycling facilities. Please do not use plastic bags to bundle your recycling or recycle plastic bags all together.



The practice of removing plastic bags from the local recycling stream will reduce strain on the recycling facilities and landfills. Contamination is the primary reason why recycling is ending up in the landfills. Please help increase the local recycling footprint while reducing pressure on the local haulers and disposal facilities. Arugula Lovers

Simple recipes, using similar ingredients making it easier to shop

Both recipes call for Arugula, Feta Cheese, and Sun Flower Seeds with slight variations but using the same balsamic vinaigrette dressing. Add your favorite protein to make it your main meal!

Simple Beet, Arugula and Feta Salad

Prep Time: 15 mins

Yield: 4 salads

4 tablespoons roasted and salted sun flower seeds

4 medium red beets

Handful arugula, roughly chopped

1/2 cup crumbled feta

Peel the rough skin from the beets with a vegetable peeler. If you have a mandoline, use it to slice the beets into thin matchsticks (watch your fingers!), if not, hold onto the rough end of the beet and slice the beet into super thin rounds, starting at the tip and working your way to the rough top. Discard the rough top. Working in batches, stack the rounds on top of each other and slice them into long, thin matchsticks. In a medium-sized serving bowl, combine the beets, arugula, crumbled feta and seeds. Drizzle in just enough dressing to lightly coat the salad once tossed. Toss and serve. cookieandkate.com

Colorful Strawberry Arugula Salad

Prep Time: 25 minutes

Yield: 4 salads

5 ounces arugula

1/2 cup chopped fresh basil

1-pound strawberries, thinly sliced

3/4 cup finely chopped red onion

4 ounces crumbled feta

1/2 cup roasted and salted sunflower seeds

1/2 cup halved and thinly sliced radish

On a *large* serving platter or in a large serving bowl, layer the ingredients as listed.

Prepare the Vinaigrette

In a liquid measuring cup or small bowl, combine all the ingredients and whisk until fully blended. Taste, and add more salt or pepper if needed. The dressing should be nice and tangy, but you can add more honey for balance if desired. When you're ready to serve the salad, drizzle vinaigrette on top, and toss to combine. Serve promptly. Stored separately, leftovers will keep well for 3 to 4 days. cookieandkate.com

Pool Season Begins May 25th... Do You Know Where Your Pool Passes Are?

Applications and forms referenced in this notice can be found online at broadlandshoa.org under amenities and pool information, or at the HOA office located in the Nature Center, and may be either dropped off in person at the Nature Center or emailed to info@broadlandshoa.com. For more information contact the Broadlands HOA office at 703-729-9704 or email info@broadlandshoa.com.

Everyone aged 5 and older will need a **Broadlands Photo ID Pool Pass** to gain admission to the pools. Below is information on what's needed in order to obtain a pool pass. If you need to get a pool pass for the upcoming season, and you are 18 or older, you must provide proof of residency in order to obtain a pool pass. **IF YOU ARE AN OWNER AND ALREADY HAVE POOL PASSES, YOU DO NOT NEED TO SUBMIT AN APPLICATION.** Your existing pool passes will be electronically reactivated. If you cannot locate your pool passes, replacements can be issued free of charge during the month of April ONLY. Beginning May 1st, reprints will cost \$5.00 each. If you want a new picture for your replacement pass, the cost is \$7.00, regardless of when the pass is issued.

New Owners: To have pool passes issued, complete an "Owner - 2019 Pool Membership Application", bring it to the HOA office at the Nature Center and have photos taken of each individual. Pool passes are issued to members aged 5 and older living in the household. A household consists of all persons living in the dwelling, including college students, other non-resident children spending the swim season in Broadlands, and live-in care providers or others showing proof of residency in the form of a valid driver's license or other government issued ID or utility bill.

Tenants (new and existing): Owners who wish to transfer their pool rights to their tenant must complete the "Absentee Owner Statement (AOS) – Facilities Use Agreement for Tenants" form and submit it, along with the tenant lease, to the HOA office. Tenants must then complete the "Tenant - 2019 Pool Membership Application" form and show proof of residency in the form of a valid driver's license or other government issued ID or utility bill to obtain a pool pass. In this instance, pool passes will ONLY be issued to the tenants; and NOT to owners. Existing tenants with valid AOS forms on file may use previously issued pool passes however; tenant pool passes will only be valid through the end of their lease date. If a lease date has expired and will be renewed, it is the tenant/owner responsibility to complete a new AOS form and submit it, along with a copy of the new lease and/or extension of the existing lease, to the HOA office PRIOR to the lease expiration.

Children: Children who have turned 5 years old, or will be 5 years old by June 1, 2019, must have a pool pass for the upcoming pool season. An "Owner – 2019 Pool Membership Application" must be filled out by the parent and the child shall be brought to the HOA office to have a photo taken and a pool pass issued. Families with children under 5 years old may obtain pool passes in order for them to bring guests to the pool. This will allow members under the age of 5 the opportunity to have older guests accompany them when other family members are not available. **Children whose passes have outdated photos that appear to be older than the last five (5) years will need to have their photos updated. New photos shall be taken at the Nature Center and updated pool passes will be provided. There is no charge for updating a photo for a child's pool pass. Any individual who has turned 18 since the last pool season will need a new adult pass and will be required to provide proof of residency. There is no charge for providing a new adult pool pass to these individuals.**

Long-Term Guest Passes: Long-Term Guest Passes are offered to allow visiting guests to use the pools unaccompanied by residents. The cost for the entire 2019 season is \$100 per person. This price will reduce on July 1 to \$75 per person and again on August 1 to \$50 per person. They should be noted as a long-term guest on the pool application. The fee must be paid at the time their photo is taken and the pass is issued. The resident member must accompany the long-term guest to the photo session and show proof of identity and address.

Guest passes: 10 resident guest passes are allocated to each **residence**. Additional guest passes, good for 10 visits, may be purchased for \$20. Members are limited to bringing 3 guests per member per visit to the pool. Guest passes are added to the electronic account of each residence and no physical passes will be issued. Guests must be accompanied by a pool pass holder to gain admittance to the pool facility. Rules regarding the use of guest passes can be found online at broadlandshoa.org.

Pictures: Beginning April 1, 2019, pictures will be taken at the Nature Center from 9:00 a.m. - 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday on a first come first served basis. **Walk-in applications will not be processed for same day delivery if received after 4:00pm.** In order to expedite lines and shorten your wait time, you may submit your application in advance via email to info@broadlandshoa.com or mail/hand delivery to 21907 Claiborne Parkway or fax to 703-729-9733.

Proof of Residency: Prior to having a photo taken, all adults 18 and older must show a photo ID with proof residency at a Broadlands Association residential address. **Photos will not be taken if acceptable proof of identity and address are not available.**

Acceptable photo IDs include:

- Driver's License
- School, Military ID
- Current Passport

If ID does not show a Broadlands Association address, the following will be accepted:

- Utility bill issued within the last 60 days
- Settlement Papers or Deed
- Current Virginia Voter Registration Card



POOL GENERAL RULES

- Children under 13 years of age must be accompanied and supervised by an adult 18 years of age or over.
- Children under 16 years must pass the Swim test to use the diving board and slide.
- Guests must be accompanied by members with pool ID. Each member is limited to bringing 3 guests per visit.
- Members must use guest passes for each guest aged 5 and older.
- **NO** glass containers or breakable objects.
- **NO** food or drink except in designated areas.
- **NO** alcohol or drugs.
- **NO** smoking.
- **NO** pets.
- **NO** chewing gum.
- **NO** profane language.
- **NO** running, pushing, dunking, wrestling or rough play.
- **NO** general swimming in diving area.
- **NO** water toys or other equipment unless authorized by pool manager.
- **NO** play equipment or wheeled vehicles, except wheel chairs and strollers.
- **NO** diving in shallow area.
- **NO** tape players, CD players or radios unless waterproof and used with personal headphones.
- **NO** floatation devices except water wings, U.S.C.G. approved life vests and U.S.C.G. approved swimwear floatation devices
- **NO DISPOSABLE DIAPERS.** Children not yet toilet trained must wear plastic pants or "Swimmies" (swim diaper) under their bathing suit.
- Pool members are responsible for the conduct of their guests.
- Adults are responsible for the safety and conduct of all children in their care.
- Pool membership may be temporarily suspended or revoked for failing to comply with the pool rules.
- Members and their guests using the pools do so at their own risk.
- No lifeguards are on duty at the wading pools.

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

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


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
