

Loudoun County Home Improvement Programs



EMERGENCY HOME REPAIR AND ACCESSIBILITY GRANT PROGRAM

- One-time grants of up to \$5,000 for homeowners who are at least 62 years old and/or have a household member with a disability for repairs related to emergencies and accessibility needs.
- Total gross household income must be at or below 50% of Area Median Income.*

LOUDOUN COUNTY HOME IMPROVEMENT PROGRAM (LCHIP)

- Loans for qualified homeowners to remedy health hazards, building code violations, accessibility issues, and conditions deemed to be blighting influences.
- Loans can be forgivable and/or interest free.
- Total gross household income must be at or below 80% of Area Median Income.*

EASTERN LOUDOUN COUNTY HOME REVITALIZATION PROGRAM (LCHRP)

- Loans for owners of homes located east of Route 15 for renovations to ensure code compliance, structural safety, external upkeep, and compliance with Homeowners' Association architectural regulations.
- Total gross household income must be at or below 100% of Area Median Income.*
