Rob will talk about the non-profit charity Comfort Cases, which supports children, ages newborn to 18 years of age, who enter the foster care system. Comfort Cases provides kids with a case containing essential items such as toothpaste, shampoo, pajamas, a book or journal, and a blanket, so they do not have to carry their belongings in a trash bag. This charity helps provide dignity to kids going through the journey of being placed in the foster care system and provides them with the notion that someone cares about what they are going through.
