Call for Candidates

The most important meeting of the year will be held on Tuesday, May 5th at 7:00pm at the Broadlands Clubhouse – The Annual Meeting of the Membership. This meeting, held every year in order to elect the Board of Directors, is required by the Bylaws for Broadlands Association, Inc. and the quorum requirement is at least ten percent of the total number of votes of the association which must be present in person or by proxy. You will receive official notification of this meeting via USPS mail around April 1. We have contracted with The Inspectors of Election (TIE Vote) for the last several years in order to simplify the voting process and provide for an online voting option for the ease of residents unable to attend the meeting in person.

Included in this publication is the Call for Candidates, inviting you to get involved by volunteering to serve on the Board of Directors. Please take time to review this information and consider submitting your candidate application to serve your community. Volunteering to serve on the Board is generally a three-year commitment, which includes 12 monthly Board meetings plus the Annual and one Budget Meeting. This year, we have four positions open for election – three members for a three-year term and one member for a two-year term. Monthly Board meetings are scheduled on the second Tuesday of each month at 6:00pm and last an average of two hours, with dinner served. Between meetings, you may be requested to review emails, respond to resident inquiries, and you are asked to review all board package material in advance of the meetings, which are distributed electronically the week before the meeting.

Some of the powers and duties of the Board include (also may be contracted or otherwise hired out):

- Providing goods and services in accordance with the documents and providing for the upkeep of the common area (e.g. mowing the common areas, providing trash services, operating the pools, maintaining the trail system)
- Designating, hiring, and dismissing personnel necessary
 to providing for the upkeep of the common area and
 providing goods and services (e.g. approving contracts
 with the grounds, trash, and pool management
 companies as well as hiring association employees to
 oversee contractors and inspect properties)
- Collecting and depositing assessments (this is contracted out to a financial management company)
- Adopting and amending rules and regulations (e.g. approving Design Guidelines, Rules for Fitness Center Use, Charters for Committees, Resolutions for Parking of Vehicles)
- Opening bank accounts (as needed, generally contracted through the financial management company)
- Enforcing provisions of the documents (e.g. holding

- violation hearings for owners who fail to comply with violation notices)
- Obtaining and carrying insurance (several policies currently in place for property, liability, officers and directors, workers comp, cyber liability, etc and are bid out every few years)
- Paying for authorized goods and services (overseen by employees and financial management)
- Charging reasonable fees for the use of the common area (e.g. establishing fee structure for fitness center use, community center rentals, outside pool memberships)
- Suspending the right of an owner or occupant to vote or to use common area (as necessary for delinquent owners or those in violation of the covenants)
- Preparing and adopting an annual budget and establishing assessments (partaking in annual budget review process with General Manager and Board)
- Employing a managing agent (the association currently employs a full time General Manager, nine full and part time administrative employees, and contracts for financial management)

The full list of powers and duties can be found in the Bylaws for Broadlands.

The Articles of Incorporation provide that the Board be comprised of nine people elected to serve in staggered terms of three years. Eligible Board Members include owners, owner's spouses, an officer, trustee, general partner or agent of an owner, the Declarant or designee of the Declarant, or a mortgagee or designee of the mortgagee. Owners or representatives of owners may not be more than sixty days delinquent in meeting financial obligations to the association.

Mandatory Phase Out of Freon (R22)

The HVAC industry has now hit the mandatory phase out of Freon (R22) for residential and commercial HVAC units. Many of our clients are still unaware of the phase out or are unclear about how it will affect them. The more you know about what is going to happen with R22, the better you will be able to prepare for what needs to happen with their aging R22-dependent systems.

R22 Phase Out Timelinearch 2020

R22 is now phased out worldwide because of its harmful effects on the ozone layer. The U.S. Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) set January 1, 2020 as the date when R22 was banned from production and importation in the United States.

As of now, R22 cannot be manufactured in the U.S. and it cannot be imported. R22 still in use in residential and commercial HVAC systems will not be affected.

What Does the R22 Phase Out Mean for Maintenance and Repairs?

The R22 phase out date means that since January 1, 2020, HVAC systems that use R22 will be obsolete. If the repair requires adding R22 refrigerant to the system, the only options will be reclaimed and previously-produced R22 refrigerant.

As you know, while some simple electrical repairs do not require recharging the refrigerant, most service calls do require a refrigerant recharge.

HVAC system owners that have leaky systems and that have been periodically injecting new R22 into the system will be forced to replace their system.

As of now, R22 can still be used in repairs and maintenance. But, the supplies of R22 are already shrinking. As the year progresses, the smaller the global supply of R22 will be available. This has ready lead the costs of the refrigerant to soar—making certain once routine repairs cost prohibitive.

Obviously, it is not wise to install a system now that uses R22. But, what about our clienTs who already own R22-dependent systems?

These customers can continue to use their systems after January 1, 2020 and get as much useful life as possible out of their systems, until they need a repair. But, this course of action means they may be forced to make an emergency HVAC system replacement which will be much more expensive than a well-planned HVAC system update. For most HVAC owners, this is indeed a gamble.

Some R22 units may be able to be converted to use a different refrigerant. However, many conversions may only buy the customers a few more years of useful life. The numbers for many system owners will not favor retrofitting.

The best option, but the one most customers dread, is replacing their system proactively or at the least replacing a system when it fails. This gives them the most reliability and cost predictability.

Covenants Corner

Throughout the year, the Covenants Manager routinely inspects homes for a variety of issues ranging from trash containers in open view, parking issues, architectural modifications to leftover holiday décor. In addition, certain seasons dictate the need to focus on particular inspections where violations may occur with high frequency.

This helps preserve the property values for home ownership, promotes community harmony and ensures the high standards of living that our residents have come to expect are maintained.

When violations typically are noted, the owner will be mailed a letter providing sixty days for the violation to be resolved. If the violation is not corrected, a second violation letter will be issued, providing an additional fifteen day extension. If the violation remains unresolved, a final notice will be sent, providing seven days to rectify before a Hearing Notice is sent, and a Hearing will be held in accordance with state law, where charges may be assessed, up to \$10/day for a maximum of ninety (90) days.

Please Tie Your Trash Down on Windy Days

Please be sure to bind newspapers with twine or place loose papers in paper bags before setting out at your curb. Weigh down your bottles, plastics and cans by placing heavier recyclables on top. Ensure that the lid of your trash can is tightly secured. Put smaller lightweight bags of trash together in a larger heavyweight bag. Don't put trash out early and PLEASE no loose "peanuts" or other packing materials. Lastly, if the trash does blow over, or you see a bin out of place, please pick it up even if it isn't yours. Your HOA assessment provides for curbside trash removal. There is no budgeted amount for litter removal. The Association relies on homeowners to keep their neighborhoods free of litter and their assessments reasonable.

Dear Broadlands Homeowner:

The 2020 Annual Meeting of the members of Broadlands Association, Inc. will be held on Tuesday, May 5th, 2020. Please mark your calendars for this important meeting and plan to attend. The purpose of the meeting is to elect members to the Board of Directors, including three (3) members to serve three-year terms expiring May 2023 and one (1) member to serve a two-year term expiring May 2022. The Board oversees the business of Broadlands in the collection and expenditure of association funds, selection of contractors, management of facilities, and adoption of policies for the day-to-day operations. These volunteer Board Members are a vital asset to the association.

To become a Director, you must be a Unit Owner in good standing. The Board currently meets monthly on the second Tuesday of the month at 6:00pm in the Broadlands Clubhouse.

If you are interested in serving, please complete a Nominating Form and Petition for Candidacy and return both documents to the Broadlands Association, Inc. office by 5:00pm on **Friday, March 20**th, **2020.** Only the enclosed Elections Committee approved nomination forms may be used. If you would like an electronic copy, you can find it on **broadlandshoa.org** or may request via email at **sarah@broadlandshoa.com**.

The Broadlands Association, Inc. Bylaws require that at least three other owners sign the Candidate Petition, which must be received by the Association no less than twenty-five (25) days before the Annual Meeting to be eligible to be included on the Ballot. All members will be mailed a proxy form containing the names of all eligible candidates with the official notice of the Annual Meeting.

As in prior years, the Board has contracted with The Inspectors of Election, LLC to act as an independent third-party election service. This provides the Association's members the option to vote via paper Proxy Ballots or vote your Proxy online via their TIEÜVOTETM voting website. The online system offers you an easy way to vote in a secure, quick and cost-effective manner.

The Inspectors of Election will mail the official annual meeting notice and election package on or about April 1st, 2020, which will contain unique login information for each unit to access the TIEĹVOTE™ voting website. Proxies should either be submitted online via the voting website or will need to be mailed, faxed, or scanned to the Inspectors of Election, LLC. Proxy forms will not be accepted at the HOA Office.

NEW POOL REGISTRATION PROCESS IN 2020

Beginning this year, Broadlands Association, Inc. is using an online registration and virtual ID process for access to our pools – this means NO MORE PHYSICAL CARDS to carry or lose! ALL RESIDENTS, including existing pool pass holders, must complete the new online registration through the Cellbadge portal and come in for new photos in order to gain access to our pools this season.

REGISTRATION REQUIRES THE FOLLOWING MULTI-STEP APPROVAL PROCESS:

STEP 1 - CREATE HOUSEHOLD ACCOUNT: Upon accessing the registration site, under *Initial Add Request*, please enter the information as a primary resident in order to create a master household account. This initial add request will be forwarded to HOA staff who will validate your residency and account status. Please allow 2-3 business days for the initial approval to be processed. Once validated, you will receive a text/email indicating that your registration has been added but will remain pending until the registration is updated with household members (STEP 3).

STEP 2 - ACQUIRE PIN: After you have received a text/email that your registration has been added, please return to the same registration page and follow the instructions under *Enter or Update Household Members*. Enter your credentials to get your unique PIN via text/email to continue the process.

STEP 3 - ADD HOUSEHOLD MEMBERS: Enter PIN to access the *Household Members* page to add all household members, ages 5 and older, including childcare providers that live with you. Once finished, check the box to verify you have agreed to the facility terms and click *Complete Registration*. Please allow 2-3 business days for approval, upon which you will receive a text/email indicating that *your Broadlands HOA registration has been accepted*, however, you must complete STEP 4 (pictures) to gain access to the pools.

STEP 4 - PICTURES: Once your registration has been accepted, all members will be required to come to the HOA office located at 21907 Claiborne Parkway to have new pictures taken and uploaded into the new system. **Photos from the old system will not transfer.** Members 18 and older must bring a photo ID showing proof of residency. Pictures can be taken Monday-Friday, 9:00am to 5:00pm <u>as long as your online registration is complete.</u> After-hour processing will be available starting in March – please refer to the newsletter, Broadlands Blast, and website for details.





ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

ACCESSING THE POOL: Once your photo has been taken, your process is complete, and access to the pools is simple since no pass is required – just check-in with the lifeguard by providing your name and address and they will be able to access your "virtual ID card" and photo in the system to allow access.

GUEST VISITS: 10-visits will be added to your household account each year. You may purchase additional visits through the HOA office in increments of 10 for \$20. Visits do not roll over to the next season.

TENANTS: You must have a current Absentee Owner Statement (AOS) and lease on file with the HOA before you register at the link above. Please see our website at https://www.broadlandshoa.org/tenant-information for full details.



2 tablespoons of each: chopped parsley, scallions & chives

8 slices white bread

4 slices Irish cheddar cheese

Jar of bread and butter pickles

Mash 4 tablespoons softened butter with chopped parsley, scallions and chives. Spread the mixture on 4 slices white bread; top each with sliced Irish cheddar cheese and bread-and-butter pickles. Cover with 4 more bread slices. Spread plain butter on the outside of the sandwiches and fry in a skillet until golden on both sides. Spread the remaining herb butter on the warm sandwiches. Ultimate Grilled Cheese

Serves 6-8

12 slices thick-cut bacon, cooked

1 cup good mayonnaise

1/4 cup Dijon mustard

1/4 cup freshly grated Parmesan cheese

1 1/2 teaspoons kosher salt

1/2 teaspoon freshly ground black pepper

1 white pullman loaf or sourdough bread, sliced 1/2-inch-thick (12 slices)

6 tablespoons salted butter, at room temperature

6 ounces aged Gruyere or Comte cheese

6 ounces extra-sharp Cheddar

Combine mayonnaise, mustard, Parmesan, salt, and pepper in a small bowl. Lay 12 slices of bread on a board and spread each one lightly with butter. Flip the slices and spread each one generously with the mayonnaise mixture. Don't neglect the corners! Grate the cheeses in a food processor fitted with the largest grating disk and combine. Distribute the bacon evenly on half the slices of bread. Pile 1/3 cup grated cheese evenly on top of the bacon and top with the remaining bread slices, sauce side down. Meanwhile, heat an electric panini press or skillet. When hot, cook the sandwiches for 3 to 5 minutes in batches until the bread is toasted and the cheese is melted, flipping if using skillet. Allow to cool for 2 in half minutes. Cut and serve warm. Foodnetwork.com



Grilled Cheese with Everything Bagel Seasoning

Serves 2

1/4 cup cream cheese, at room temperature

3 scallions, sliced

1 tablespoon butter, plus more as needed

4 thick slices seeded wheat or country white bread

2 ounces mozzarella, thinly shaved or sliced

4 slices tomato, cut into half-moons

4 thin slices red onion, cut into half-moons

1 tablespoon capers

Everything Bagel Seasoning, buy or make your own and mix these together:

1 teaspoon sesame seeds

3/4 teaspoon poppy seeds

1/2 teaspoon dried minced garlic

1/2 teaspoon dried minced onion

1/4 teaspoon kosher salt

Mix together the cream cheese and scallions until well combined. Melt the butter in a large skillet over medium heat. Add the bread slices and toast until lightly browned on one side; remove to a cutting board, toasted side up (the toasted sides will become the insides of your sandwich). Spread all four slices with scallion cream cheese, then sprinkle with Everything Bagel Seasoning. Top two of the slices with mozzarella, sliced tomato and red onion. Press the capers into the cream cheese on the other two slices. Form sandwiches. Add a bit more butter to the skillet if it seems dry. Place the sandwiches in the skillet, cover with a lid and cook until toasted on the bottom, 3 to 5 minutes.
